Levelling the playing field

The AGF Junior Girls Scholarship Program, launched in 2021 by the AGF through the foresight and generosity of Foundation Director Bonnie Boezeman AO, aims to create greater opportunities for girls aged nine to 16 to engage in golf.

While participation in golf is increasing, women and girls are under-represented at just 20% of total participation.¹

The program has already granted over 4,500 scholarships, providing girls with coaching, junior membership for one year, and a Golf Australia (GA) handicap to start their lifelong journey in golf in a fun, inclusive and engaging environment.

Scholars can also join a newly formed alumni network, offering benefits such as reciprocal playing rights at other courses, discounted green fees, and participation in special events.

Additionally, girls can continue to develop their golf skills through pathway programs or further education opportunities at the PGA of Australia Learning Hub, including the PGA Academy membership pathway program.

The program has been highly successful, with 82% of participants retaining club membership after completion, demonstrating the positive impact of philanthropy in golf.

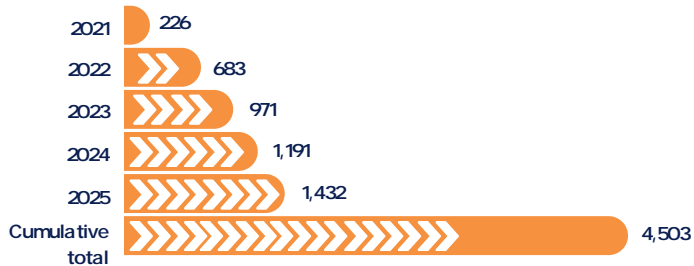
